- 1 Pinot Grigio** Ca' Luca, Veneto, Italy
A clean well-balanced dry white with delicate perfume and fresh appley fruit. Ca' Luca retains a refined acidity matching subtle peach and pear flavours lingering on the finish.

- 2 Sauvignon Blanc** Los Caminos, Colchagua Valley, Chile
A vibrant aromatic Sauvignon Blanc with a floral bouquet of nettle and grapefruit balanced by gooseberry, passion fruit and pleasant acidity.

- 3 Chardonnay** Hamilton Heights South Eastern Australia
An elegant and finely balanced wine with tropical fruit notes of mango and pineapple combined with ripe peach and pear. A crisp acidity gives a wonderful lively mouth feel and the finish is long and smooth.

- 4 Picpoul de Pinet** 'Trois Mats', Languedoc, France
A bright, fresh Languedoc white from the coastal flatlands of Sete which abounds with fragrant aromas of white flowers, quince and anis followed by ginger and citrus notes. It is lively on the palate with notes of lemon, melon and honey finishing crisp and dry with matured crystallised citrus fruits.

- 5 Merlot** Los Caminos, Colchagua Valley, Chile
An easy drinking, distinguished and vibrantly fruity Merlot. The palate is rich with black cherry and plum flavours with a hint of mineral character and soft, rounded structure.

- 6 Rioja Tempranillo** Tunante, Rioja, Spain
A vibrant, unoaked and supple red made exclusively from Tempranillo grapes. Plummy, soft and seductive with typical Tempranillo character of red fruits and liquorice and a soft round finish.

- 7 Malbec** Punto Alto, Mendoza, Argentina
Organically grown, a dark purple in colour with bramble fruits and black cherries on the nose. Great concentration with velvety texture, dark fruits and chocolate on the finish.

- 8 Pinot Noir** 1620 Lorgeril, Languedoc, France
Very intense nose, dominated by aromas of fresh blackcurrants. The palate smooth with light tannins and flavours of soft black fruits.

- 9 Pinot Grigio 'Ramato'** Il Barco, Veneto, Italy
Delicate perfumed aromas of peach and rose petals with soft, red fruit flavours on the palate. It is dry and well balanced, excellent to drink with fish and white meats.

- 10 'Essenciel' Rosé** Coteaux d'Aix en Provence, France
A traditional dry Provençal rosé made by the saignée method of `bleeding` the juice from the skins to preserve delicacy and character. It is elegant and dry with aromatic fruit aromas derived from a vibrant blend of Cabernet and Syrah.

From our local vineyard, a blend of Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier. Elegant and dry with summer strawberries and cream flavour.

- 12 Prosecco** Ti Amo, Italy
Italy's finest sparkling wine, with delicate fruit and soft intensity.

- 13 Brouilly** Cuvée de la Bruyère, Beaujolais, France £ 29.00
Ripe with red fruits and showing exceptional concentration from low yielding 80-year-old Gamay vines. Smooth and refreshing with morello cherry flavours and a light smoky finish.
- 14 Carmenere 'Reserve'** La Playa Block 13, Chile £ 28.50
This premium oak reserve Carmenere delivers full rich ripe fruit flavours on the palate and a strong expressive finish.
- 15 Nero D'Avola** Musita Sicily, Italy £ 28.00
Bright ruby in colour with notes of cherry and plum on the nose. The palate is soft and round with juicy dark fruits and a chocolate character on the finish.
- 16 Château Cabans** Cru Bourgeois, Médoc, France £40.00
The fruit is soft, ripe and appealing, balanced by supple, ripe tannins. Exotic blackcurrant, cherry and chocolate flavours lift the palate, finishing warm and raisiny.
- 17 Salice Salentino** Riserva Il Tauro, Italy £25.50
Full and ripe with a distinctive plum and chocolate character, attractive underlying leather and mineral flavour and subtle bitterness on the finish.
- 18 Côtes du Rhône** Domaine De L'Amandine, France £27.00
The spice and smoky aromas of the Syrah dominate the bouquet, whilst red fruits and spice compete on the palate.
- 19 Pinot Noir** 'Alpataco', Familia Schroeder, Patagonia, Argentina £25.50
Perfumed aromas of black cherry, redcurrant and summer fruit with plenty of power, spice and a silky balance. Sweet tannins and balanced acidity with fine notes of vanilla and cocoa powder.
- 20 Shiraz Pinotage** Tulbagh Winery, Tulbagh Valley, South Africa £24.50
An intense almost black colour with berry fruit and spicy, smoky aromas followed by ripe plum and hints of coffee and chocolate. The palate is restrained and medium with dark cherry flavours.
- 21 Rioja Reserva** Bodegas Taron, Spain £32.50
The palate is soft with notes of red cherries, red currants, citrus peel, cinnamon, balsamic and toast. Soft tannins and a fresh acidity gives structure to the wine which finishes long and complex.

Red Wines

- 22 Fleurie 'Poncié'** Patrick Tranchand, France £30.00
A fresh and fruity Fleurie from 65 year old vines. Soft on the palate with notes of raspberries, red cherries and violets.
- 23 Château Louvie** Grand Cru Saint Émilion France £46.00
The blend of 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon creates a wine which has a soft and smooth mouthfeel with plenty of berry and plum fruits combined with woodland scents and a long savoury finish.
- 24 Savigny lés Beaune 'Lés Gollards'** Domaine Prieuré France £34.00
This elegant perfumed 1er Cru Savigny preserves the complex raspberry fruit flavours, distinct mineral character and power inherited from the iron rich soil.
- 25 Pinot Noir 'Roaring Meg'**, Mt Difficulty, Central Otago, New Zealand £36.00
A lovely mix of red and black berry fruits with further complexity gained from oak spice. The wine has a sweet berry entry which displays these same characters in abundance.
- 26 Châteauneuf du Pape** Domaine Monpertuis, Vignobles Paul Jeune France £49.00
A peppery nose with wild herbs and cedar precedes a palate rich with attractive mulberry and blackcurrant fruits and a strong spicy finish.
- 27 Gevrey Chambertin** Domaine Lucien Boillot France £70.00
An intense perfumed Gevrey with cherry and redcurrant aromas, powerful with fine tannins and ripe, silky fruit lingering on the finish.
- 28 Réserve d'Angludet** Margaux France £55.00
A perfumed bouquet of red fruits with earthy undertones gives way to supple dark fruits, licorice and spice balanced by assertive ripe tannins.

Rosé Wines

- 29 Ladybird Rose** Laibach Vineyards South Africa £27.00
On the nose a lovely array of strawberry and cherry blossom. Summer fruits explode onto the palate and leave a fresh aftertaste of strawberries and tropical fruits with a lovely, fresh acidity.
- 30 'Whispering Angel' Rosé** Château d'Esclans, France £38.00
A pale partridge eye pink with perfumed bouquet, which follows with elegant summer fruits. The palate is refined and elegant with faint cherry nuances and beautifully integrated balancing acidity.

White Wines

- 31 Viognier** La Playa, Chile £ 27.00
A perfumed apricot and rose petal scent gives this easy drinking white a captivating fragrance whilst flavours of dried fruits and lychee enliven a fresh and dry palate.
- 32 Sauvignon Blanc** 'Family Vineyard', Wairau River, Marlborough, New Zealand £ 28.50
A vibrant, citrusy wine with an aroma of fresh gooseberries and packed with tropical fruit flavours.
- 33 Mâcon Villages** Domaine de Rochebin, France £ 28.00
Pale lemon in colour, with citrus and apple notes, a hint of white blossom and faint traces of butter. Apple and citrus predominate on the palate along with a hint of pear, finishing on a lovely streak of steely minerality.
- 34 Chardonnay** Sur Lie Bon Vallon, de Wetshof Estate, Robertson, South Africa £ 28.00
The nose is delicate with aromas of lemon, honeysuckle blossom and peach. The wine was matured on its lees to produce a vibrant, lemony dry wine with a yeasty and delicate nutty finish.
- 35 Albarino** 'Condes de Albarei', Rias Biexas, Galicia, Spain £ 32.50
The Albariño grape variety thrives on its cool coastal location in the Galicia region of Northern Spain and produces fresh elegant wines with a captivating floral bouquet and apple, pear and peach flavours.
- 36 Chablis** Domaine Gautheron France £ 32.00
This Chablis offers fresh, floral aromas, appley fruit and complex, rich mineral character derived from the subtle influence of the chalky vineyard soils. Fermentation and maturation is in vat to preserve the fresh steely flavours and lively balanced citrus finish.
- 37 Gavi di Gavi** Cantine Volpi, Piedmont, Italy £ 33.00
Lemony dry with a perfumed mineral character, aromas of peach and flowers, lingering hints of vanilla and soft-textured dry finish.
- 38 Chenin Blanc** Backsberg Estate South Africa £ 28.50
Pear, green apple and cashew provide an array of aromatic characters. Ripe fruit is tempered by finely balanced acidity to give a mouth filling, yet refreshing palate, which has a lingering finish.
- 39 Sancerre** André Neveu France £ 35.00
The Sauvignon blanc grape excels in this rich, flinty soil. This single vineyard Sancerre has the added complexity of mineral and herbaceous flavours on the palate. The immense long flavour of gooseberries and blackcurrant leaves lingers on the finish.
- 40 Pouilly Fuissé** 'Les Crays' Domaine Auvigue France £ 44.00
Jean Auvigue produces Pouilly Fuissé of the highest quality with vibrant Chardonnay fruit. It is rich with mineral flavours while a brief maturation in wooden cask adds spice and complexity.

Champagne

- 41 **Lanson Black Label** N V £57.50
Fine mousse of bubbles and a toasty, honeyed nose in perfect balance.
- 42 **Lanson Brut Rosé** N V £67.50
Beautiful pure colour, fresh and delicious with aromas of roses and fruit.

Sparkling Wine

- 43 **Prosecco Brut** Spumante Extra Dry 'Borgo Del Col Alto', Italy £28.00
A delicately fruity aromatic bouquet with hints of flowers, honey and green apple is matched by a delightful fine mousse and fresh, clean palate.
- 44 **Cremant de Loire Brut** Domaine Amirault, Methode Traditionelle, France £33.50
Pale lemon in colour with notes of baked apples on the nose. The palate has a lovely, soft mousse with notes of lemon, apple, honeysuckle and brioche. The racy acidity of the Chenin Blanc leaves a very crisp and clean impression on the palate.
